4. Paths numbered with the prefix '7' were originally in an adjoining parish but have been affected by a diversion or parish boundary change since 1st January 1964
5. Paths numbered with the prefix '9' were in an adjoining county on 1st January 1964

New Alresford 2	Footpath	5903 3241 Sun Lane	5940 3238 Bishops Sutton 9 at parish boundary	<u>From Road U.181 at Railway Bridge to Parish Boundary</u> From U.181 through gap, eastwards along 4ft. wide gravel path enclosed between fences to the Parish Boundary. Shown on the New Alresford Award Map dated 1807 prior to construction of railway. Route as shown on Draft Map now diverted.
New Alresford 3	Footpath	5883 3269 West Street	5902 3243 Sun Lane	<u>From Road A.31, West Street, to Road U.181 at Railway Bridge</u> From A.31 through church gate, south eastwards along 3ft. wide tarmac path through church yard, through gap then along tarmac path enclosed approximately 5ft. wide between wall and fence to Road U.181. Shown on the New Alresford Award dated 1807 prior to construction of railway. Route as shown on Draft map now diverted.
New Alresford 4	Footpath	5883 3268 Footpath 3	5883 3256 Station Road	<u>From No. 3 at Church to Road U.181, Station Road</u> From No. 3 south westwards along 3ft. wide tarmac path through church yard, through gap, then along enclosed path approximately 5ft wide between walls to Road U.181 at Police Station.
New Alresford 6	Footpath	5867 3252 Jacklyns Lane	5881 3256 Station Road	<u>From Road U.181 to Road B.3046</u> From U.181 south westwards along 9ft. wide gravel track enclosed between fences and hedges, then narrowing to 4ft. wide, to Road B.3046. Shown on the New Alresford Award map dated 1807 as a footway 6ft. wide.
New Alresford 7	Footpath	5882 3254 Station Road	5876 3251 Footpath 8	<u>From Road U.181 opposite Police Station to Station Approach Road</u> From U.181 south westwards along 3ft. wide tarmac path enclosed between fences to Station Approach Road.
New Alresford 8	Footpath	5876 3251 Footpath 7	5875 3254 Footpath 6	<u>From No. 7 at Junction with Station Approach Road to junction with No. 6</u> From No. 7 northwards along 10ft. wide gravel track to junction with No. 6.
New Alresford 9	Footpath	5841 3295 The Dean	5791 3301 Old Alresford 4 at parish boundary	<u>From Road U.184, The Dean to Parish Boundary</u> From U.184 westwards along earth path on river bank, over culvert, then along grass path on river bank, over stile, along grass path, over 3ft. wide footbridge at Eel House and along earth path to Parish Boundary. Shown on the New Alresford Award Map dated 1807 as a footway 6ft. wide.
New Alresford 10	Footpath	5841 3295 The Dean	5843 3311 Old Alresford 6 at parish boundary	<u>From Road U.184, The Dean to Parish Boundary</u> From U.184 northwards along gravel path, over 3ft. wide footbridge, then along gravel path to Parish Boundary. Shown on the New Alresford Award Map dated 1807 as a footway 6ft. wide.

New Alresford 11	Footpath	5877 3297 Mill Hill	5844 3311 Footpath 10	<p><u>From U184 at Mill Hill to Junction with No. 10 at Fulling Mill</u> From U.184 north westwards along 9ft. wide gravel road (Spring Lane) enclosed between hedges, then along earth path on banks of watercress beds to junction with No. 10 at Fulling Mill. Shown on New Alresford Award Map dated 1807 as a footway 6ft. wide.</p>	
New Alresford 12	Footpath	5883 3296 The Soke	5879 3298 Mill Hill	<p><u>From Road B.3046 to Road U.184 at Town Mill</u> From B.3046 north westwards along 9ft. wide gravel road enclosed between walls then westwards along earth path and over 3ft. wide footbridge at Town Mill to junction with Road U.184.</p>
