Nutley 5	Bridleway	6103 4454 Farleigh Road	6183 4386 Berrydown Lane	<u>From Road B.3046 at Nutley to Road C.12 at Bermondspit House</u> From B.3046 through field gate southeastwards along verge of pasture, over bar fence, along verge of pasture, over bar fence along headland of arable fields, through gap (loose wired) then along grass track enclosed approximately 12 ft. wide between hedge and wire fence and then between hedges to Road C.12. Shown on the Nutley Inclosure Award dated 1823 as a 10 ft. wide bridle road and footpath.
Nutley 6	Bridleway	6190 4390 Ellisfield 16 at parish boundary	6243 4565 Farleigh Wallop 7 at parish boundary	<u>From Parish Boundary near Bermondspit House to Parish Boundary at Nortons Wood</u> Northeastwards along verge of pasture, through gap (loose wired) along verge of pasture, through field gate along grass track unenclosed across downland, then along grass track through Norton's Wood to Parish Boundary.
Nutley 7a	Byway Open to All Traffic	5924 4370 Duxford Lane	5924 4282 BOAT 501	<u>From C.12 west of Flockmoor Farm to Parish Boundary</u> From C.12 southwards along grass track enclosed approximately 8 ft. wide between hedges then southeastwards along grass headland of arable field on west side of hedge, then through gap and along earth track on east side of hedges enclosed approximately 12 ft. between hedge and fence, to Parish Boundary.
