1. Save as otherwise provided, the prefix SU applies to all grid references
2. The majority of the statements set out in column 5 were prepared between 1950 and 1964 and have not been revised save as provided by column 6
3. Paths numbered with the prefix '5' were added to the definitive map after 1st January 1964
4. Paths numbered with the prefix '7' were originally in an adjoining parish but have been affected by a diversion or parish boundary change since 1st January 1964
5. Paths numbered with the prefix '9' were in an adjoining county on 1st January 1964
6. Columns 3 and 4 do not form part of the Definitive Statement and are included for information only

Sandleheath 7108	Bridleway	1213 1511 Road B3078	1176 1467 Damerham 46 at Parish Boundary	<p><u>From Road B.3078 at Sandleheath to Parish Boundary</u></p> <p>From Road B.3078 westwards along 10 ft. wide gravelled track unenclosed across wasteland then southwards along 10 ft. wide gravelled track enclosed 12 ft. wide between hedges and fences, then southwards along grass path 10 ft. wide enclosed 12 ft. wide between fence and hedge narrowing to 2 ft. wide enclosed 10 ft. wide between hedges to Parish Boundary.</p>	
Sandleheath 7109	Footpath	1234 1490 Road C148	1231 1481 Road C245	<p><u>From Road B.3078 at Sandleheath to Road C.245</u></p> <p>From Road B.3078 southwestwards along unenclosed 15 ft. wide gravelled track across waste land, along 5 ft. wide gravelled track on north side of buildings, southwards through cycle obstruction posts, along 2 ft. wide metalled path enclosed between hedges, and through cycle obstruction posts to Road C.245.</p> <p>Shown on the Inclosure Award for Sandhill Heath dated 1865 as a public footway 4 ft. wide.</p>
