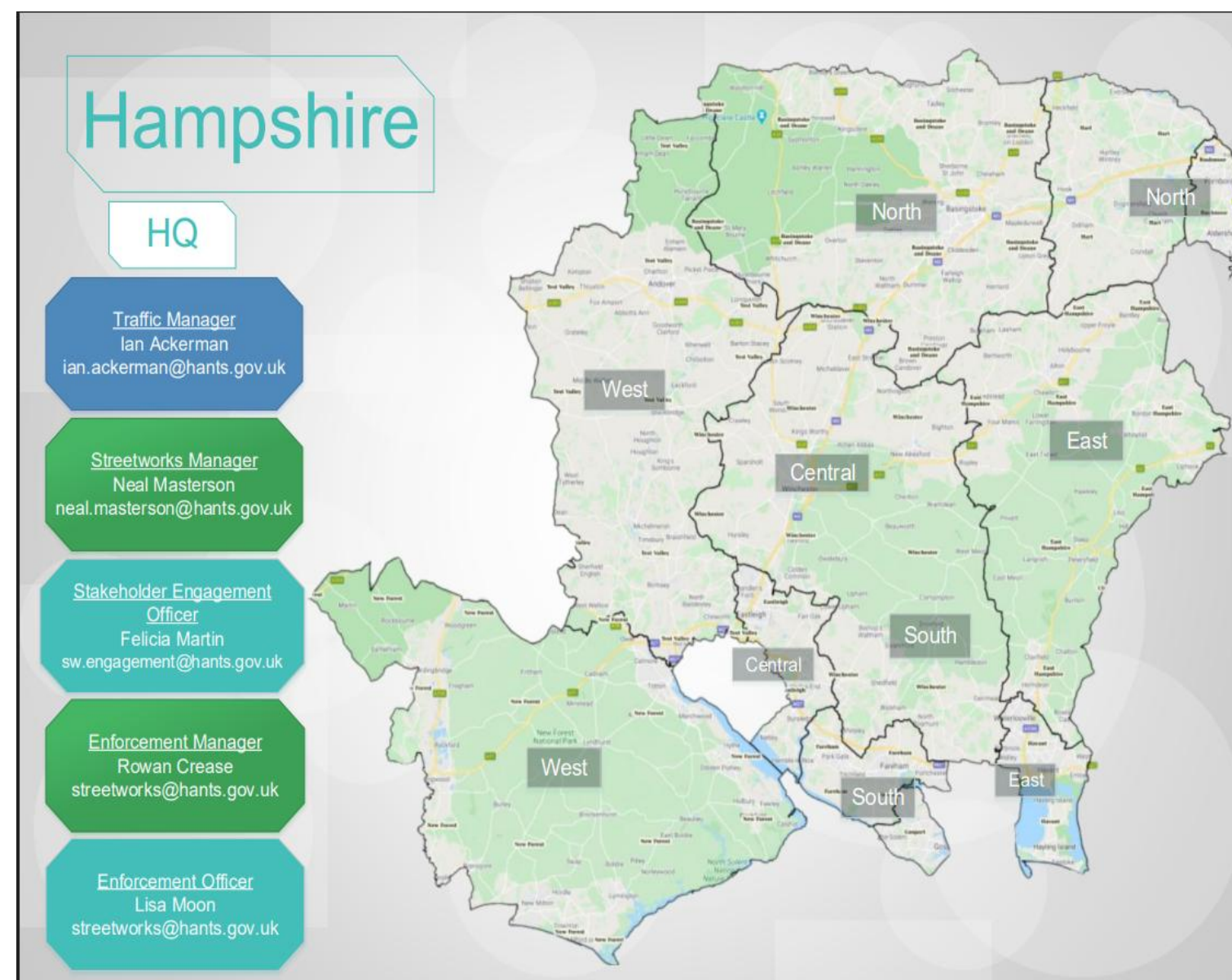

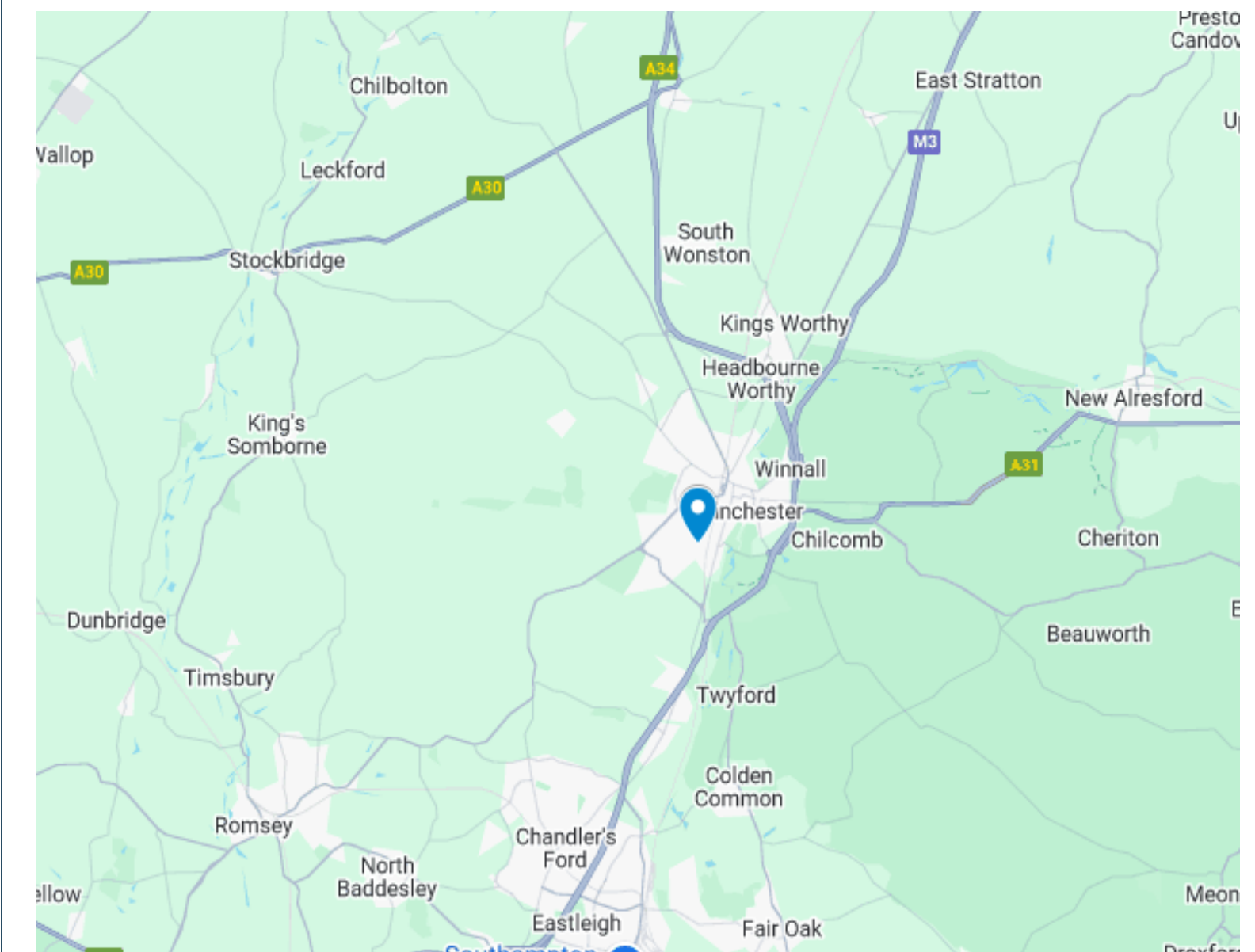

# Reminders

🔥 **Hot topics:** these are the subjects that generate complaints from members of the public and Councillors. 🔥

**Verges:** we suggest taking photographs of verges before you start work to document any existing damage. You should also take photographs once site is cleared to show the condition of grassed areas after you leave. Please ensure that any damage caused to verges/grassed areas as a result of your work is made good before you leave.

**Use of 15-minute road closures:** please only use at sensible times

**Working hours:** please ensure all contractors and operatives are aware of permit conditions. We are seeing an increase in evening and night works in residential areas in breach of permit conditions.

**Environmental Health:** if you are planning to work in a residential area at night for more than one night, you must alert the local EH team.

**Manual Control:** the purpose of manual control is to control the traffic flow. Please ensure that the operative in charge is aware of any priorities at different times of the day.

**Hants HAUC Meeting:** Scheduled for the 12<sup>th</sup> May via Teams. Focus will be regional and National strategic issues.

**Blocked Driveways:** please consider notifying residents before blocking driveways.

**Diversions:** please remember that the shortest route is not always the best. We have seen an increase in wholly unsuitable diversions being selected, leading to damage to the highway, incidents involving the police, and irate members of the public. When applying for a TTRO, the applicant must confirm that a risk assessment has been carried out – please ensure that this is the case for all signed alternative routes.

**Bus Stops:** please remember to suspend bus stops if they will not be accessible due to your works.

**Gentle reminder:** please be careful not to include any of the streetworks named people in the permit information that will be displayed publicly on Causeway one.network

**And:** Please note that, where possible, works should be avoided in the New Forest during the school holiday periods.

**New Forest Tourism Restriction – works with long-duration positive TM on A, B and C roads in the New Forest** near tourist attractions, shopping areas, or caravan/campsites **may be restricted from Easter to end of September.** Consult the coordination team before submitting permits.

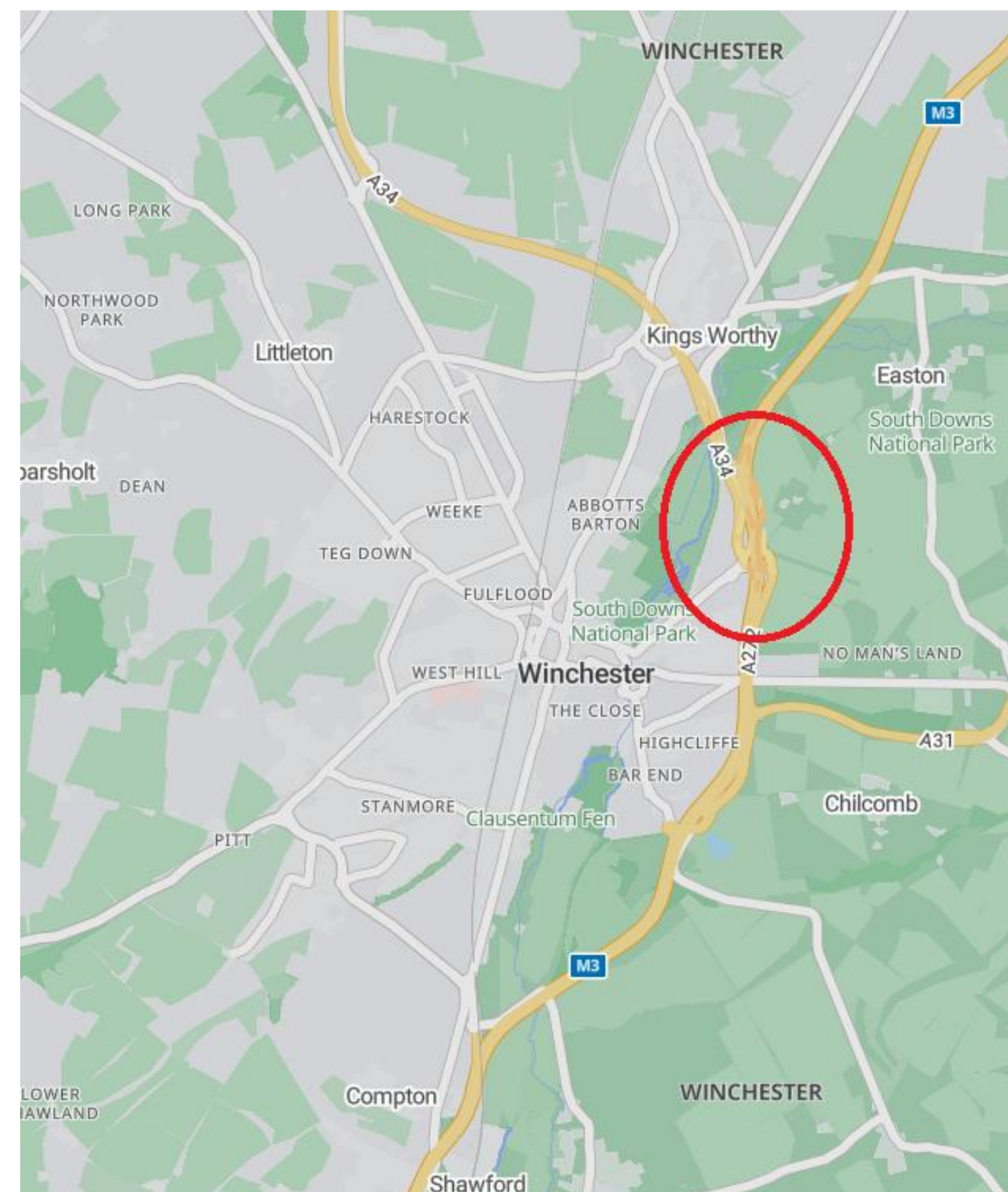

National Highways DCO. 2024 to 2029.

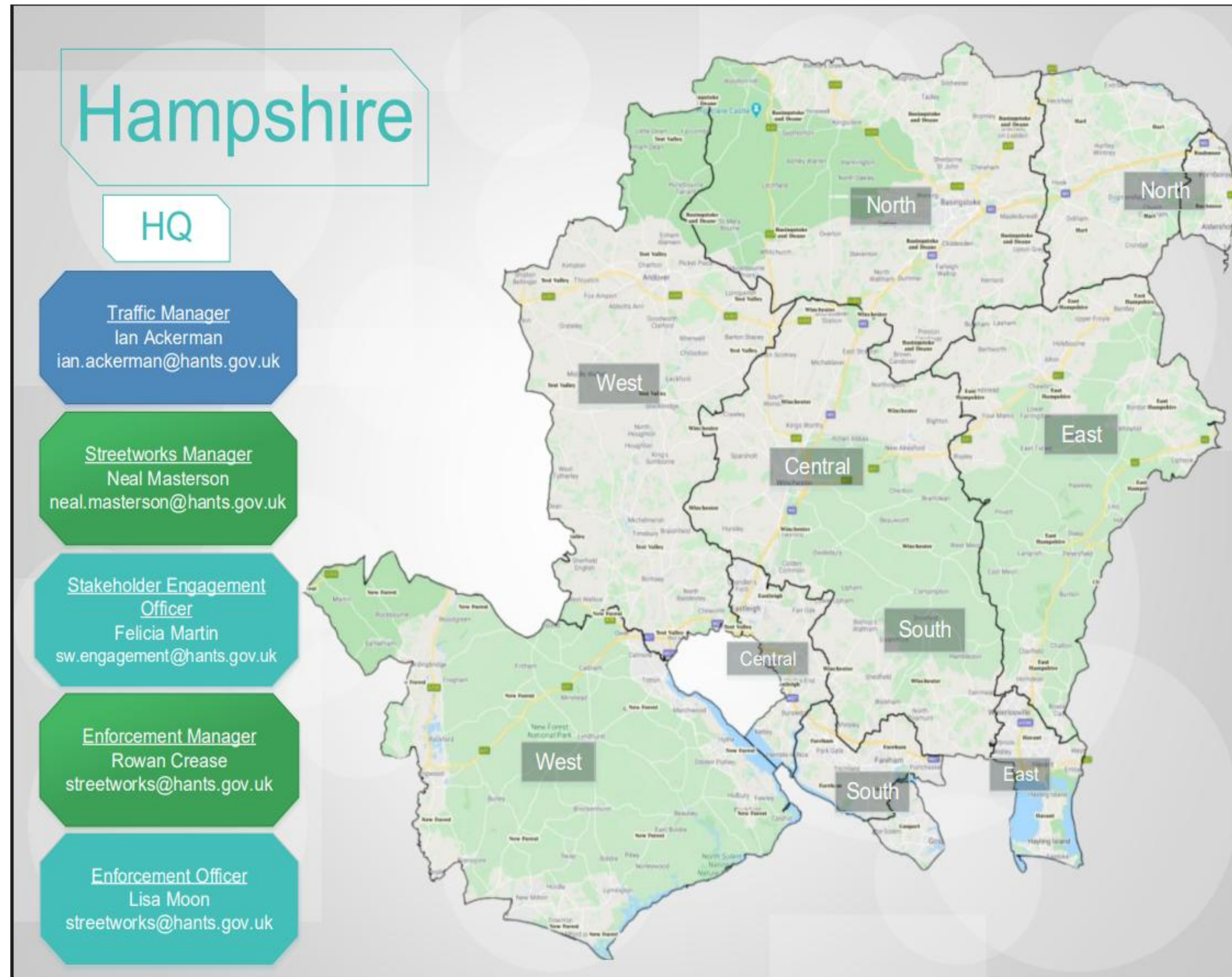

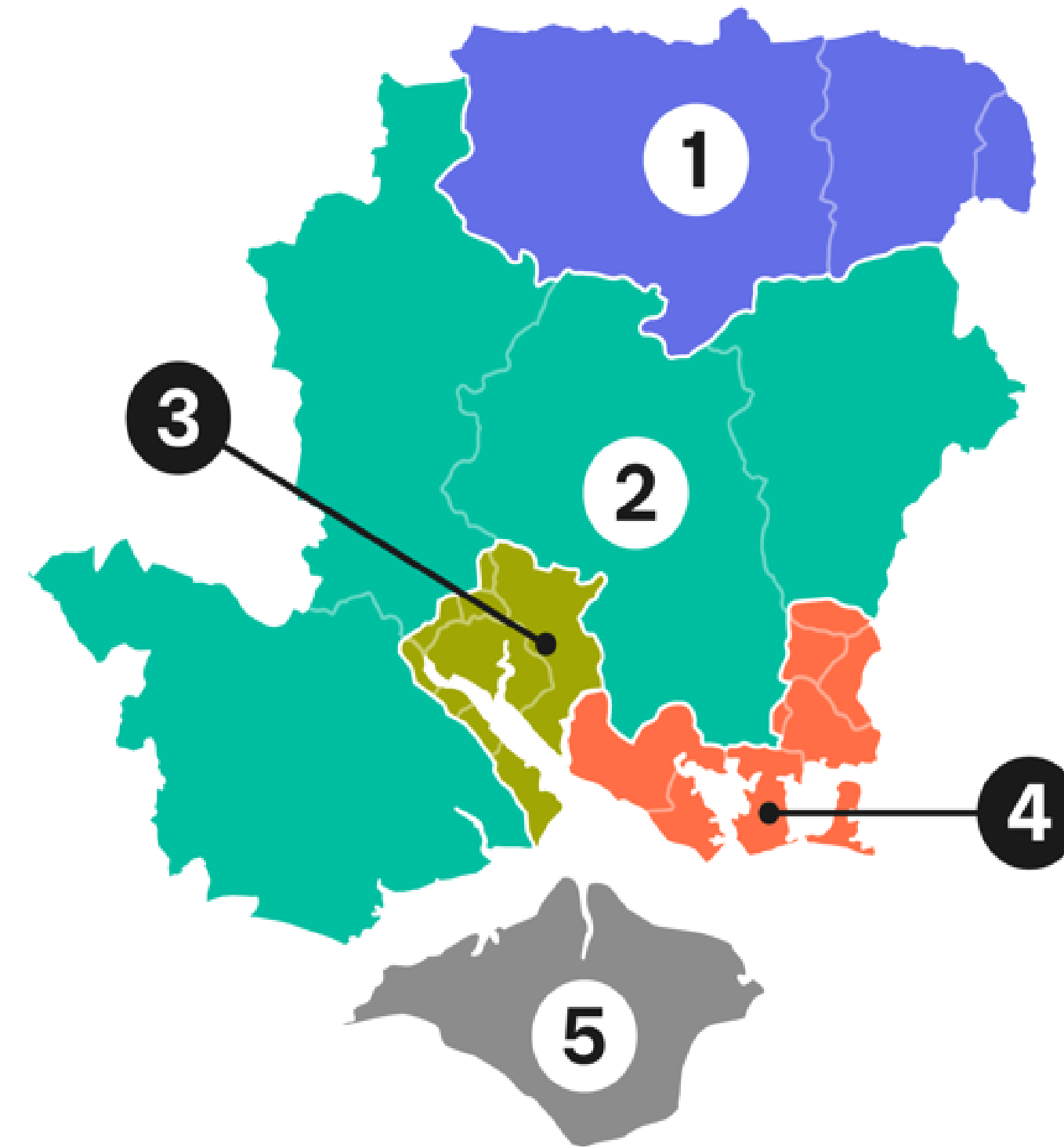
# Government announces new councils for Hampshire and the Solent area

The Government has announced its decision on the future of local councils across Hampshire and the Solent area, creating five new unitary (all-purpose) councils to replace the current 15 councils serving the area (Hampshire County Council, 11 district and borough councils, and the unitary councils of Southampton, Portsmouth and the Isle of Wight).

- 3 South West Hampshire
- 4 South East Hampshire
- 5 Isle of Wight



# The new councils announced are:

## **North Hampshire:**

Basingstoke, Hart and Rushmoor

## **Mid Hampshire:**

New Forest, Test Valley, Winchester and East Hampshire

## **South West Hampshire:**

Eastleigh and Southampton

## **South East Hampshire:**

Portsmouth, Havant, Gosport and Fareham

## **Isle of Wight**

This model also includes the following boundary changes:

Move the parishes of Totton and Eling, Marchwood, Hythe and Dibden, Fawley (currently under New Forest District Council) and Chilworth, Nursling, Rownhams and Valley Park (currently under Test Valley Borough Council) to the proposed South West Unitary.

Move the parishes of Newlands (currently under Winchester City Council) Clanfield, Horndean and Rowlands Castle

(currently under East Hampshire District Council) to the proposed South East unitary.

**These councils are expected to be in place from April 2028, when each new one will be responsible for delivering all local services in its area.**

- Consultation summary document has been added to the HCC website. Further docs will be added shortly
- The scheme documents have been modified in accordance with the outcome of the consultation. Some consultation comments will feed into the 'daily' working documents that are still in development
- Most significant changes were to the timings that LR would apply and the network that it would apply to
- Changes are currently being applied to the key Traffic Sensitive network with traffic count evidence obtained to support the timings for each USRN affected
- Application made to the DfT in late March

# Permit Scheme Update:

# Permit Scheme 'Highlights'

2022 to 2025 report circulated to HAUC members at the end of March. Summary as follows;

- The high volume of works means roadspace is at a premium.
- 2022-2025 permit scheme report shows scheme is working well. And volumes of permits remain high.
- Finance report for the 2022-2025 shows that the scheme recovered approx. 400K more than the scheme cost to run. HCC is in the process of seeking legal advice on how to resolve this over-recovery.
- Owing to the significant increase in permits now being processed the team will shortly be seeking to employ additional staff.
- In the 2024/2025 year;
  - 87% of works on a traffic sensitive street had a condition placed on them relating to timing of the works.
  - 97% of planned works requiring a road closure had a condition placed on them regarding advanced publicity
  - 93% of inspected works complied with permit conditions
  - 2233 works duration extensions were requested
  - 51% of works were planned "minor" works
  - 31% of works were "immediate" works (35% in the previous year)
