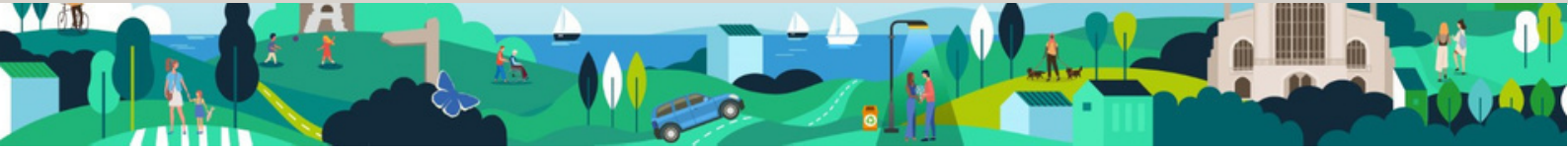

Verges are still a hot topic, especially for local councillors. We suggest taking photographs of verges before you start work to document any existing damage. You should also take photographs once site is cleared to show the condition of grassed areas after you leave.

Please ensure that any damage caused to verges/grassed areas as a result of your work is made good before you leave.

HCC is regularly receiving complaints from residents due to lack of information from telecoms companies, especially relating to access to driveways. Installation of telegraph poles and new cabinets currently a hot topic

HCC has noticed a significant increase of interest from MPs and Councillors. This could drive conditions or further enquiries from works

Road closure orders are now all dealt with by Hampshire County Council.

It is important to remember that road closures require a permit (street works team) and a temporary traffic regulation order.

## **Performance**

In the 2023/2024 financial year, there were around 73,000 permits submitted to HCC (that's over 200 a day!) with 92% of permits being granted.

On the inspection side, the pass rate for Cat As was 93.6%, the pass rate for Cat Bs was 95.8% and the pass rate for Cat Cs was 97.6%. This is excellent results and has been reflected in the PBIs across the board.

There were 869 FPNs issued, mostly for late start, stop and reinstatement notices and 271 overruns recorded.
