

## What is the Andover Villages Taxishare?

It is a public transport service for anyone who needs to travel from Ragged Appleshaw and Penton Mewsey into Andover.

The service is similar to a bus service, except that passengers will need to book in advance and the journey will be operated by a taxi instead of a bus.

### How much will it cost?

From 1 April 2023, the service will cost £1\* for each single journey.

Children under 5 may travel free.

\*Prices valid as of April 2023, subject to change in April 2024.

### Accessibility

Folding wheelchairs and pushchairs can be accommodated. Please speak to the service operator when booking your journey.

A public transport service for passengers travelling from Ragged Appleshaw and Penton Mewsey into Andover.

## Where will I be picked up from?

The taxi will pick you up from bus stops along the route as per the timetable. If you are unable to get to a bus stop due to a mobility issue, then the taxi may be able to pick you up from your home address.

## Where can I travel to?

Pre-booked passengers will be dropped off/picked up Andover Station or at Stand I, Andover Bus Station.
