

## What is the Burley Taxishare?

It is a public transport service for passengers who need to travel from Lyndhurst, Burley or Ringwood Town Centre.

The service is similar to a bus service, except that passengers will need to book in advance and the journey will be operated by a taxi instead of a bus.

## How much will it cost?

From 1 April 2023, the service will cost £1\* for each single journey.

Children under 5 may travel free.

\*Prices valid as of April 2023, subject to change in April 2024.

## Accessibility

Folding wheelchairs and pushchairs can be accommodated. Please speak to the service operator when booking your journey.

A public transport service for passengers travelling to and from Lyndhurst, Burley and Ringwood.

### Where can I travel to?

Pre-booked passengers will be able to travel to and from Ringwood Town Centre, Burley, Burley Street, or Lyndhurst Town Centre.

### Where will I be picked up?

The taxi will pick you up from your nearest bus stop from the following list:

Burley – Chubbs Farm, Pound Farm, Warnes Lane, Coach House, Queens Head, Burley School and Burley Street

Lyndhurst – The Lyndhurst Park Hotel and Crown Inn
