

What is the Burridge to Swanwick and Park Gate Taxishare?

It is a public transport service for anyone who needs to travel from Burridge and Curbridge into Swanwick and Park Gate.

The service is similar to a bus service, except that passengers will need to book in advance and the journey will be operated by a taxi instead of a bus.

How much will it cost?

From 1 April 2023, the service will cost £1* for each single journey.

Children under 5 may travel free.

*Prices valid as of April 2023, subject to change in April 2024.

Folding wheelchairs and pushchairs can be accommodated. Please speak to the service operator when booking your journey.

Pre-booked passengers will be dropped off/picked up at Swanwick rail station or Park Gate (Bridge Road bus stop).

Where will I be picked up from?

The Carshare will pick up from the following bus stops along the line of route:

- Burridge Sports and Social Club
- Bury Farm
- Curbridge
- Horse and Jockey
- Fairthorne Manor
