

What is the Chilworth and Upton Crescent Taxishare?

It is a public transport service for anyone who needs to travel from Chilworth, the central part of Balmoral Way, or Upton Crescent to Lord's Hill.

The service is similar to a bus service, except that passengers will need to book in advance and the journey will be operated by a taxi instead of a bus.

How much will it cost?

From 1 April 2023, the service will cost £1* for each single journey.

Children under 5 may travel free.

*Prices valid as of April 2023, subject to change in April 2024.

Folding wheelchairs and pushchairs can be accommodated. Please speak to the service operator when booking your journey.
