

What is the X57 Taxishare?

It is a public transport service for anyone who needs to travel from Linden Lea, Hill View Road and Leith Avenue to Fareham Town Centre or Portchester Precinct.

The service is similar to a bus service, except that passengers need to book in advance and the journey will be operated by a taxi instead of a bus.

How much will it cost?

From 1 April 2023, the service will cost £1* for each single journey.

Children under 5 may travel free.

*Prices valid as of April 2023, subject to change in April 2024.

Folding wheelchairs and pushchairs can be accommodated. Please speak to the service operator when booking your journey.

Arrives Portchester	10.00am

Return journeys

Leaves Portchester	12.00pm
Linden Lea Bus Stops	12.15pm
Leith Avenue	12.20pm

You will then be sent a membership pack with the booking number to ring when you would like to travel.
