

## What is the Hart to Alton Taxishare?

It is a public transport service for residents living in:-

- Crondall
- Ewshot
- Dogmersfield
- Winchfield
- Fleet
- Pondtail
- Odiham
- Mattingley
- Hook
- Well
- North Warnborough
- Hartley Wintney
- Church Crookham
- Mapledurwell
- Upton Grey

Anyone living in the areas above who fit the following criteria can use the taxishare:

- You do not have access to a car;
- There is not a bus service that runs when you would like to travel;
- You live more than 400m from your nearest bus stop;
- You find it difficult to use a conventional bus service due to a sensory or mobility difficulty; or
- You are accompanying someone who fits any of the above criteria.

The service is similar to a bus service, except that passengers will need to book in advance and the journey will be operated by a taxi instead of a bus.

### Connect

Connect is a bookable door-to-door accessible transport service for those who are unable to use or access public bus services.

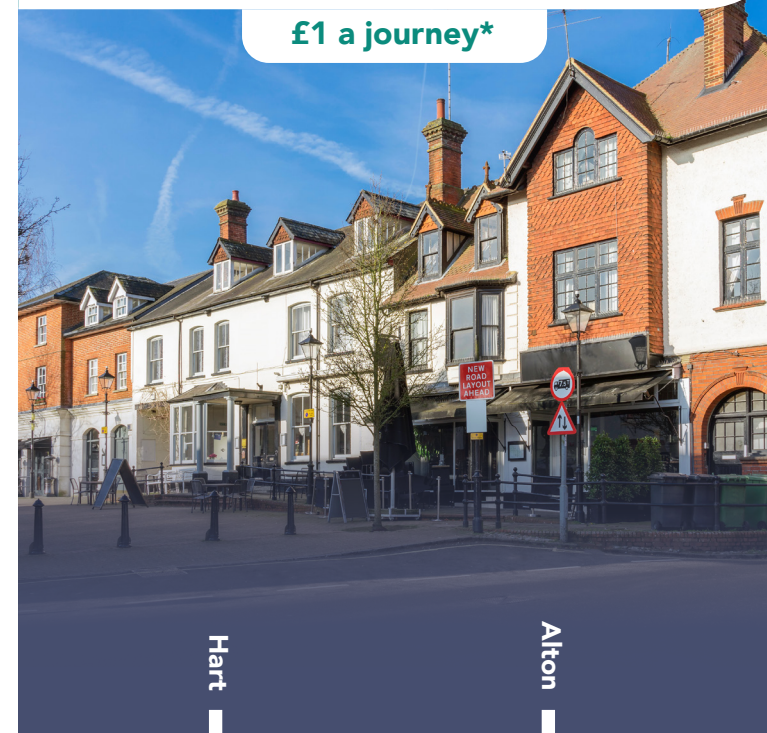

## 200A The Hart to Alton Taxishare

### How much will it cost?

From 1 April 2023, the service will cost £1\* for each single journey.

Children under 5 may travel free.

\*Prices valid as of April 2023, subject to change in April 2024.

### Where can I travel to?

Pre-booked passengers can travel to:

- Alton

### Accessibility

Folding wheelchairs and pushchairs can be accommodated. Please speak to the service operator when booking your journey.

### Where will I be picked up from?

The vehicle will pick you up from your nearest bus stop. If you are unable to get to a bus stop due to a mobility issue then you can get picked up from your home address or a convenient place nearby.

### When can I travel?

The service operates to Alton on the first Tuesday of every month and will pick you up from 9.30am and return you at approximately 2pm.
