**Notice to Designate a Street as Protected: Templars Way / Louisburg Avenue -
new A325 Relief Road, Whitehill & Bordon**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN

Under Schedule 1 Part 1 of the Street Works (Registers, Notices, Directions and Designations) (England) Regulations 2007/1951, Hampshire County Council ('County Council') intends to designate the relief road Whitehill & Bordon Phase 2 (known as 'Templars Way / Louisburg Avenue - new A325 Relief Road') so that consent of the street authority will be required for the placing of apparatus by any undertaker under Section 61 of the Act.

Any objections in respect of the proposed designation should be received by the County Council from any statutory undertaker/authority/adjacent owner to which the proposed designation refers by the 19th November 2019.
